## Ice Cream Cone Card

## Supplies

All supplies Stampin' Up! unless noted.

- Stamps: Curly Cute
- Ink: Real Red
- Card stock: Crumb Cake, Whisper White, Subtles Designer Series Paper Stacks, Glimmer Paper
- Accessories: Petal Cone Die, Big Shot Die Cut Machine, Square Lattice Embossing Folder, Dimenionals, 3/4 Circle Punch, Square Punch, Tabletop Trimmer


## CuttingMeasurements



- Crumb Cake CS: Cut one Petal Cone
- Whisper White: Cut one Petal Cone
- Pretty in Pink Designer Series Paper : $5 \times 5 / 8$
- Pretty in Pink Designer Series Paper : Scallop from Petal Cone Die
- Glimmer Paper: Scraps to punch 3/4 Circle

Instructions (Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.)
I. Cut all of the card stock by following the Cutting Measurements above.
2. Start with the Crumb Cake piece and cut off the flap on the side and one at the top.
3. Close the cone and emboss it with the Square Lattice embossing folder.
4. For the white Petal cone, trim it until it layers inside the card (using Tabletop Trimmer).
5. Attach the half scallop to the cone (adding adhesive to the crumb cake).
6. Add Dimensional to back of Glimmer paper (cherry on top) and add it to the card.
7. Stamp "happy birthday" with Real Red ink on the $5 / 8 \times 5$ piece of designer paper.
8. Using a Square Punch, position it on the end to make it a pennant. (see video).
9. Your card is complete...enjoy!
