Mother's Day Mini Scrapbook

Supplies

All supplies Stampin' Up! unless noted.

- Stamps: Something to Celebrate & Clearly for You
- Ink: Early Espresso, Baja Breeze
- Card stock: Wild Wasabi 12 x 12 Textured, Very Vanilla, First Edition DSP, Baja Breeze, Wild Wasabi DSP in Soft Subtles DSP Stacks
- Accessories: Early Espresso Taffeta Ribbon, Scallop Edge Border Punch, Linen Thread, Crop-A-Dile, Sponges, 2-3/8 Scallop Circle Punch, 1-3/4 Circle Punch, Wild Wasabi Marker, Dimensionals, Snail Adhesive, Hobby Blade, Mat Pack, Paper Piercer, Timberbrown Stazon (retired-Stampin' Up)



Cutting Measurements

- Wild Wasabi CS: 11-1/2 x 4-1/2 and Scored at 1-1/8, 5-5/8 & 10-1/8
- Very Vanilla CS: 3 pieces cut at 81/2 x 4-1/4 & Scored at 4 1/4
- First Edition DSP: 4-7/16 x 1-1/2
- Baja Breeze CS: Scraps for Scallop Punch
- Very Vanilla CS: Scraps for Circle Punch
- Wild Wasabi DSP: 4 x4

Instructions (Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.)

- Fold Wild Wasabi CS on Score Lines.
- 2. Stamp Happy Mother's Day centered on front of Scrapbook using Timberbrown Stazon Ink.
- 3. Fold Very Vanilla CS on Score Lines and place inside Scrapbook.
- **4.** Punch two holes along fold using Crop-A-Dile.
- 5. Thread Linen Thread through holes two times and tie in back, creating book pages.
- **6.** Punch inside flaps of book with the Scallop Edge Border Punch.
- **7.** Sponge edges of First Edition DSP, place snail adhesive on back and attach to front of book just above Happy Mother's Day stamp. Cut two slits into the sides of the book cover flaps using the Hobby Blade.
- 8. Cut 23" of Espresso Taffeta Ribbon and slide under Vanilla CS and through each slit.

- **9.** Place snail adhesive on 1st page of Very Vanilla CS and on inside of front scallop edge then fold to create inside of book repeat process for back of book.
- Apply ink to image with Baja Breeze Ink and color in stems and leaves using Wild Wasabi Marker.
- II. Stamp image on Very Vanilla CS and punch out with 1-3/4 Circle Punch.
- 12. Sponge edges using Early Espresso Ink.
- 13. Punch out Baja Breeze CS with 2-3/8 Scallop Circle Punch with sponge edges with Early Espresso ink.
- **14.** Attach image to Baja Breeze CS using snail adhesive and attach to front of Scrapbook using two Dimensionals.
- 15. Sponge edges of Scrapbook with Early Espresso Ink.
- **16.** Open book and decorate pages with Wild Wasabi DSP found in the Soft Subtles DSP Stacks.
- 17. Your Scrapbook is complete... Enjoy!!!
