- **Stamps:** Tags til Christmas - Wood #120847
Clear #121169
- **Ink:** Early Espresso #126974
- **Card stock:** Champagne Glimmer #127885,
Very Vanilla #101650, Early Espresso
#1119686, Cherry Cobbler Core'dinations
#127846
- **Tools & Accessories:** Lacy Brocade
Embossing Folder #127819, Big Shot Die Cut
Machine #113439, Dimensionals #104430,
Sticky Strip #104294, Stampin Sanding
System #129367, Sponges #101610, Stampin
Trimmer #126889
- **Punches:** 1" Square Punch #124094,
Scallop Square Punch #119884, Corner
Punch #119871

Cutting Measurements

- **Early Espresso:** 4-5/8 x 3 -
score at 2-5/8 on each end.
- **Cherry Cobbler
Core'dinations:** 2-7/8 x 1-7/8
- **Very Vanilla:** Scraps for
stamping image
- **Champagne Glimmer:**
Scallop Square

Instructions

Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.

1. Score the Early Espresso card stock at 2-5/8 on each end and fold on the score lines.
2. Corner edges with the Corner Punch.
3. Emboss the Cherry Cobbler Core'dinations card stock with the Lacy Brocade Embossing Folder and round the edges of one side.
4. Sand the card stock with the Stampin Sanding System.
5. Apply Champagne Shimmer Paint with a sponge and then attach to the Early Espresso card stock.
6. Add the Tic Tacs using Sticky Strip.
7. Add Ribbon
8. Stamp image with Early Espresso ink (let it dry) and then cut it out with the 1" Square Punch.
9. Take the 1" Square Punch and cut out it of the Glimmer Paper ...then take the Scallop Square Punch and center it over the 1" hole and cut the Scallop.
10. Cut a Scallop Square out of the Early Espresso card stock and attach the Glimmer Paper Scallop square to it usin g Dimensionals (in the corners).
11. Attach the greeting to the center using Snail Adhesive.
12. Attach to the front with two Dimensionals (one at top and one at bottom)
13. Your Tic Tac Holder is completeEnjoy!
