Christmas Treat Holder



Supplies

Stamps: Merry & Type - Wood #122550 Clear #122552

Paper: Cherry Cobbler #119685, Early Espresso #119686, Espresso Core'dinations (optional), Shimmery White #101910

Ink: Early Espresso #126974

Punches: Corner Punch #119871, Decorative Label Punch #120907

Accessories & Tools: Cherry Tulle #127841, Espresso Tulle #127839, Lacy Brocade Embossing Folder #127819, Sponges #101610, Dimensionals #104430, Champagne Mist Shimmer Paint #116806, Big Shot Die Cut Machine #113439, Sticky Strip #104294, Sanding System #129367 (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Round the top of the Cherry Cobbler card stock with the Corner Punch.
- 2. Emboss the Early Espresso card stock using the Lacy Brocade Embossing Folder.
- Attach the Early Espresso card stock to the Cherry Cobbler using Sticky Strip. Apply it to both sides and the bottom ...leaving the top open to add your treat.
- 4. If you're using the Core'dinations card stock you can sand before or after you add it.
- 5. Spray project with Champagne Mist Shimmer Paint mixed with alcohol.
- 6. Add your treat.
- 7. Tie the Tulle around project (open it before you wrap it around) and trim ends to make them even.
- 8. Stamp Merry and Bright with Early Espresso ink onto the Shimmery White card stock and set aside to dry.
- 9. Cut a piece of Cherry Cobbler card stock with the Decorative Label Punch.
- 10. Sponged the edges of the Cherry Cobbler Decorative Label with the Champagne Mist Shimmer Paint and cut in half.
- 11. Cut out the Merry and Bright with the Decorative Label punch and add adhesive to the back to add to the Cherry Cobbler pieces.
- 12. Add Dimensionals to the back and add to your treat holder.

Measurements:

- Cherry Cobbler card stock: 6 x 4-1/4
- Early Espresso card stock: 5 x 4-1/4

Tips:

• You can use the Core'dinations card stock or the Early Espresso card stock for this project. If you use the Core'dinations you will want to use the Stampin Sanding System.
