Easter Jar



Stampin' Up! supply list for the Easter Jar:

- **Stamps:** Crosses of Hope - 117136 (W) 120567 (C)
- **Ink:** 126957 So Saffron
- **Card Stock:** 100730 White, 126922 Sunshine & Sprinkles Designer Series Paper
- **Accessories & Tools:** 122125 - 3" Circle Die, 104430 Stampin Dimensionals, 113439 Big Shot Die Cut Machine, 123126 Perfect Pennants Die, 120906 - 2-1/2 Circle Punch, 119857 Word Window Punch, 129399 Paper Doilies, 104294 Sticky Strip, 103683 Mini Glue Dots

Easter Jar Instructions

1. Please read instructions all the way through before beginning.
2. You will need an half pint Jelly Jar (wide mouth).
3. Cut out a 3" Circle Die using White CS on the Big Shot Die Cut Machine.
4. Place Dimensionals on the back of the 3" Circle and attach to top of lid.
5. Cut out Sunshine & Sprinkles DSP using Perfect Pennants Die and place Dimensionals on the back and attach to 3" White CS circle.
6. Cut out a circle using White CS with the 2-1/2 Circle Punch, place Dimensionals on back and place on top of Sunshine & Sprinkles DSP.
7. Using Crosses of Hope Stamp Set, Teeny Tiny Wishes Stamp Set and So Saffron Ink stamp the cross and Happy Easter on White CS.
8. Cut out Happy Easter with Word Window Punch - attach it to a Post-it-Note and cut out again with Word Window Punch to make it smaller.
9. Cut out the Cross using Scissors and attach Dimensionals on the back.
10. Place Cross and Happy Easter to top of jar - as seen in video.
11. Attach a 2-1/2 circle of card stock in the center of both a Paper Doilie and cut out a circle .. do this to both pieces. This forms the piece that wraps around the jar.
12. Cut a 1/2" X 11" strip of Sunshine & Sprinkles DSP, apply Sticky Strip to back and attach to rim of Jar lid.
13. Place Mini Glue Dots around the jar, determine which side you want to be the front and attach Paper Doilies - trim as needed.
14. Place Lid on Jar.
15. Your Easter Jar is complete... Enjoy!
