Instructions

1. Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.
2. Using the Envelope Punch Board place the 5 x 5 sheet of DSP on the board at 2", press the button and then score, rotate it and place it at 3", press the button and score, rotate it (to the left) and place it at 2", press the button and score, rotate it and place it at 3", press the button and score.
3. Round the edges.
4. Fold on all the score lines except the top one.
5. Place adhesive on the bottom and fold the right side over ... place adhesive on the left side and fold over.
6. Stamp the images with Black Stazon ink.
7. Cut "boo" out with the 1-1/4 Circle Punch and attach it to a 1-3/8 Black Circle. Add a Dimensional to the back and add it to a White Scallop Circle (1-3/4).
8. Using the Paper piercer punch a hole in one scallop and thread the Bakers Twine through it.
9. Tie the White & Black Taffeta Ribbon around the pocket.
10. Add image with the Bakers Twine (knot at the top).
11. Cut spider out and add him with Glue Dots.
12. Your project is completeenjoy.
