

Blessing Mix Box



Stamps: Gratitude for Days, Hardwood Background

Ink: Soft Suede, Early Espresso

Paper: Soft Suede, Crushed Curry, Whisper White

Accessories: Extra Large Oval Punch, Deco Label Framelits, Big Shot, Magnetic Platform, Glue Dots, Crushed Curry Taffeta Ribbon, Dimensionals, Simply Scored Scoring Tool, Rhinestones, Grid Paper

Measurements:

DSP: 8 x 5

Crushed Curry: Deco Label Framelit

Whisper White: Extra Large Oval

INSTRUCTIONS (Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.)

1. Score the card stock @ 1" on all four sides. Place in landscape and score @ 3-1/2 & 4-1/2.
2. Cut on the score lines ... up to the score lines .. creating tabs.
3. Fold Card Stock flat and tamp Hardwood Background on both sides.
4. Add adhesive to tabs and assemble box.
5. Stamp greeting with Early Espresso Ink and cut out with the Extra Large Oval Punch
6. Add image to a small Deco Label with a Dimensional
7. Add image to box with a Stampin' Dimensional.
8. Add Crushed Curry Taffeta Bow to the front with a Glue Dot and finish it by adding a Rhinestone.
9. Add Poem to inside lid of box or on the back.
10. Add Blessing Mix to small cello bag and place in box.

Ingredients for Blessing Mix

Bugles, Pretzels, Candy Corn, Orange Slices, Peanuts

Blessing Mix

The Bugles are a symbol of the Cornucopia, a horn of plenty.

The Pretzels represent arms folded in Thanks & Prayer.

The Candy Corn reminds us that during the first winter, the pilgrims were allowed only five kernels of corn per day because the food was scarce.

The Fruit is a reminder that Thanksgiving is the celebration of the harvest.

The Peanuts represent seeds, the potential of the bounteous harvest of the next season if they are planted and well tended.
