**Stamps:** Jar Of Haunts Photopolymer Stamp Set - 142247

**Ink:** Basic Black Archival Stampin' Pad - 140931

**Paper:** Halloween Night Specialty Designer Series Paper - 142022,  
Whisper White - 100730, Basic Black - 121045

**Accessories:** Popcorn Box Thinlits Dies - 141473, Layering Ovals Framelits Dies - 141706, Halloween Night Designer Washi Tape - 142026, Stampin' Dimensionals - 104430, Big Shot - 113439, Magnetic Platform - 130658, Tear & Tape Adhesive - 138995, Bone Folder - 102300, Stampin' Dimensionals - 104430

## Measurements

Basic Black: 5-1/4 x 5-1/4, 4-1/2 x 3/4, 2 x 3

Halloween Night DSP: 5-1/4 x 5-1/4

Whisper White: 2 x 3

## Instructions

1. Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.
2. Cut one popcorn box from 5-1/4 x 5-1/4" piece of Basic Black card stock with the Popcorn Box Thinlits using the Big Shot and Magnetic Platform.
3. Trim off notched, rectangular shaped tab from die-cut box piece. Crease and burnish score lines using Bone Folder. Assemble pocket adhering with Tear & Tape Adhesive.
4. Cut one box from 5-1/4 x 5-1/4 piece of DSP. Fold on score lines then trim panels on score lines using scissors or Stampin' Trimmer. Adhere cut panels to front and back of treat holder using adhesive.
5. Wrap 4-1/2 x 3/4 piece of Basic Black card stock around pocket adhering ends together using adhesive. Wrap Washi Tape around band.
6. Cut out oval from 2" x 3 piece of Basic Black card stock with Layering Ovals Framelits (1-1/4" wide opening) using the Big Shot and Magnetic Platform.
7. Stamp sentiment onto 2 x 3 Whisper White card stock using Basic Black ink.
8. Cut out with scallop oval (1-1/8" wide opening) from the Layering Ovals Framelits using the Big Shot and Magnetic Platform.
9. Adhere to Basic Black Oval using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Adhere both to front of treat bag using Stampin' Dimensionals.
